

April M. Jennette is offering 50.9+/- acres of land in Pike Township, Potter County, adjacent to State Game Land No. 64 (Exhibit RED 1). The option price is \$225,000 lump sum to be paid from the Commission's restricted account, representing settlement funds from environmental damage claims brought by the Commonwealth. The property will be subject to an easement for fishing access in favor of the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission. The property contains a species with a proposed status of rare on the Plants of Special Concern in Pennsylvania list. The property has over 2,000 feet of stream frontage along the Pine Creek, a high-quality, cold-water fishery. Subsurface rights were severed and reserved by prior owners. Access is

from Route 6.



Pheasants Forever is offering 71+/- acres of land in Horton Township, Elk County, an interior to State Game Land No. 44 (Exhibit RED 2). The option price is \$142,600 lump sum with the Game Fund obligation limited to \$10,718.32. The remaining \$131,881.68 is to be paid by The Conservation Fund in accordance with a prior timber-for-land exchange agreement. The tract is an interior to SGL 44 for which the Commission may pay what it considers to be a fair and reasonable price. This acquisition will improve the manageability of the existing State game lands. Subsurface rights were severed and reserved by prior owners. Access is from Drummond Road.



Commentary: Timothy A. Burnier, et al. are offering 79.3+/- acres of land in Delmar Township, Tioga County, near State Game Land No. 313 (Exhibit RED 3). The option price is \$375,000 lump sum to be paid from the Commission's restricted account, representing settlement funds from environmental damage claims brought by the Commonwealth. This parcel, being mostly wetland and wet meadow, is similar to the "Muck" section of SGL 313 to the northeast, the satellite tract to the west, and a newly acquired DCNR parcel. These parcels form a mosaic of wetlands along the Marsh Creek Valley that will provide a corridor for waterfowl and other wetland species of conservation concern. Access to the property is from State Route 6. The northwest detached parcel is accessible by a DCNR Rail Trail.






